



Admission Requirements Checklist

Master of Arts in Anthropology
Master of Applied Anthropology

- 1. Complete the online Boise State University Graduate Admission Application form (*Send to Graduate Admission and Degree Services*)
- 2. Submit GRE test scores (*Send to Graduate Admission and Degree Services*)
- 3. Submit official grade transcript of all post-secondary institutions attended (*Send to Graduate Admission and Degree Services*)
- 4. Submit Two Letters of Recommendation
(*A standardized form is available in the department or on the department website. Send to the Department of Anthropology*)
- 5. Submit a two-page (500-word) essay discussing your professional goals and describing your reasons for your interest in the program (*Send to the Department of Anthropology*)

Application Deadline

Final acceptance to either master's program is based upon the Admissions Committee's evaluation of the applicant's academic and professional accomplishments, performance on the GRE examinations, individual career goals, written recommendations, and personal essay.

Applicants will be admitted only once a year for fall semester entry. Applications and supporting materials should be received prior to **March 15** in order to be given highest priority for merit-based financial assistance. To be considered, applicants must submit the complete admission packet by **May 1**.
